Testing Strategy-Part 3



4. Test Phases

In our test strategy, we should have a clear plan of the Types and levels of testing the project will go through. A comprehensive approach should be analyzed for the project/ application. QA team should consult system architects, development team to understand the application architecture and system architecture. This will help QA team to select the test levels. Below are some of test levels selected by QA teams,

String Test – This test is done by developer, preferably in integrated environment.

Assembly Test – This test is done by QA team in integrated test environment

System Test – This test is done by QA team in system test environment for testing the functionality of the system.

System Integration Test – This test is done by QA team in integrated test environment.

UAT test – This test is done by UAT team or Business Representative.

DITL Test – This is a Day in life testing conducted by real users of the application before they Go live.

QA team should also elaborate on the types of testing planned for the project. Typical types of testing are like smoke testing, Regression testing, Negative testing, penetrative testing, boundary testing etc.

QA team should also have a plan for non functional testing in the test strategy more important like security testing & performance testing. A holistic approach should be given on security and performance testing.

5. Test Deliverables

Test strategy should have a list of all test deliverables that will be planned as a part of the project. Some of the deliverables like

- Test Plan
 - -System Test Plan
 - -System Integration/E2E Test plan
 - -UAT Test Plan
 - -Performance Test Plan
 - -Automation Test Plan
- Test Scenario
- Test Case
- Test Closure Memo/Test Summary Report
- Automation Test Scripts
- Performance Test Scripts
- Requirement Traceability Metrics


